

NAME

buf_printf - write a to a buffer using printf(3) like format

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <buf.h>
```

bool

```
buf_printf(struct buf *b, const char *fmt, ...);
```

DESCRIPTION

This function uses the printf(3) format to be appended in the buffer *b*. See the printf(3) manual page for a detailed description of *fmt* string.

RETURN VALUE

The **buf_printf()** function returns false in case of error and *errno* is set to indicate the error.

ERRORS

[ENOMEM] Couldn't allocate more memory.
