

NAME

buf_puts - append a NUL-terminated string

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <buf.h>
```

bool

```
buf_puts(struct buf *b, const char *src);
```

DESCRIPTION

Append the NUL-terminated string *src* into the buffer specified by *b*.

It is undefined behavior if *src* argument is NULL.

RETURN VALUE

The **buf_puts()** function returns false in case of error and *errno* is set to indicate the error.

ERRORS

[ENOMEM] Couldn't allocate more memory.
